WHEREAS the Author is desirous of promoting Education, Literature, Science, Charity, Social Reforms, Arts & Crafts, Cottage Industry, Social Service, Cultural Activities, Diffusion of useful knowledge and such other objects for the education of boys and girls in the educative and vocation pursuits.

AND WHEREAS the Author Considers that the above object can be satisfactorily be achieved and continued permanently, only by constituting a Public Charitable Trust.

AND WHEREAS the Author has already set a part a sum of Rs. 5000/- ( Rupees Five Thousand Only) as an initial Trust fund and transferred the same to the Trustees of this trust by cash for the purpose of constituting a Public Charitable Trust and for the objects mentioned hereinafter appearing

AND WHEREAS the following trustees have agreed to carry out the Trust herein created.

2.1.3. The first board of Trustees shall be as follows:

2.1.4. The first board of trustees appointed shall be for a period of 10 years. The first board of trustees shall appoint the required number of trustees within twelve months from the date of execution of this deed. And they shall hold the office initially for a period of three years. After the initial three years, one third of the trustees shall vacate the office at the recommendation of the advisory council.

2.1.5. In the case of any vacancy arises by natural death or accidental death of first trustee, the other remaining trustees will co-opt a successor in his or her place.

2.1.6. A trustee may tender resignation at any time by giving sixty days notice in advance to the managing trustee. The acceptance of the resignation of a trustee will be made by a resolution of the trust meeting.

2.1.7. A trustee, is disqualified who acts in contravention to the terms of this deed of declaration or any other rules framed there under or act prejudicially to the objectives of the trust or without giving reasonable cause absents himself consecutively for three meetings of Board of Trustees or is convicted, by any court, a resolution to this effect will be passed by the Board of Trustees, to remove the erring trustee. However, before disqualifying a trustee, a reasonable opportunity of being heard in writing shall be given.

## 2.2. Powers of the Board of Trustees:

2.2.1. The Board of Trustees shall hold the properties of the trust to be acquired in future on behalf of the Trust.

2.2.2. The board of trustees may authorize the managing trustee or any other members of the trust for specific purpose and for a specific time as may be necessary.

2.2.3. The Managing Trustee or The President can open bank account or accounts in the name of the trust and the same shall be operated by any one of the trustees as decided by the Board from time to time.

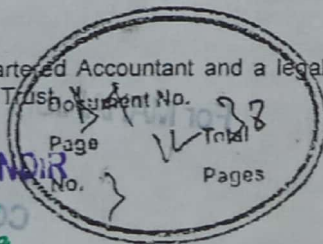
2.2.4. They are authorized to borrow from banks or financial institutions or State or Central Government and for that purpose, they can mortgage, hypothecate any of the assets of the trust.

2.2.5. They shall appoint a Chartered Accountant and a legal adviser as per the terms and conditions of the board of Trust.

- 2.2.6. They shall have the power to acquire capital assets to meet the objects of the trust.
- 2.2.7. They are authorized to sell, lease, mortgage, or otherwise deal with any of the properties of the trust both movables and immovables.
- 2.2.8. They are authorized to invest the funds of the trust in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act and Rules made there under from time to time.
- 2.2.9. The funds or income of the trust shall not directly or indirectly be made available to the author of the trust or other persons mentioned in Section 13 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 so as to directly or indirectly benefit such persons referred therein except for payment for expenses or costs incurred for services rendered for the development of the trust.
- 2.2.10. The board of trustees is empowered to take over and run any existing institutions or organization for promoting its objects.
- 2.2.11. The board of trustees is authorized to frame rules for the proper conduct and administration of the trust, but any such rule shall not be against the objects and spirit of the trust or any other conditions of this deed of trust.
- 2.2.12. The trustees will be entitled to an honorarium for their services or works actually rendered to the trust in carrying out the objects and powers of the trust and to reimburse themselves for expenses actually incurred.

**2.3. Office bearers and functions:**

The Trust shall have the following office bearers with the respective functions:

**2.3.1. President of the Trust:**

The Trust shall have a President to preside all the meeting of the Board of Trustees. The first President of the Trust shall be Mr. M.U.Rajram who shall hold this office initially for a period of two years. Thereafter the President shall be elected from and amongst the Board of Trustees to hold office at a time for a period of two years. Although the President shall be eligible for re-election. He cannot be re-elected continuously for more than five terms.

**3. MANAGEMENT OF THE AFFAIRS OF THE TRUST**

**3.1. MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:**

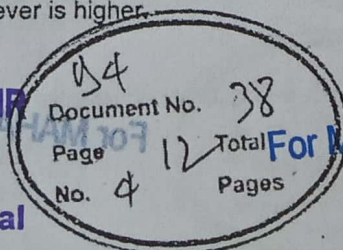
Regular meetings of the Board of trustees shall be held at least twice in a year to transact the business of the trust. The board of trustees is entitled to frame necessary rules and regulations for the proper conduct of the meetings.

**3.2. QUORUM FOR THE MEETINGS:**

The quorum for the meetings of the board of trustees shall be one half of the board of trustees or two persons whichever is higher.

**3.3. LIABILITIES AND INDEMNITY OF THE TRUSTEES:**

- 3.3.1. The trustees shall be accountable only for such money, stocks, shares and funds. As shall actually come into their hands and a trustee shall not be answerable for or accountable for neglect, default, acts of omission or commission of the other trustees nor of any banker or other person with whom the trust properties or any securities may have been deposited or kept.
- 3.3.2. The Trustee shall be kept indemnified by the trust against, action, claim, demand or liability arising against them for anything done by them in good faith, pursuant to the power of authority vested in them under these present.
- 3.3.3. Every trustee shall be indemnified out of the trust fund against all losses and expenses incurred in the discharge of their official duties except such as, shall happen through his own neglect, willful act, or default and each trustee shall be chargeable with only such money or property as he shall by himself actually receive in the discharge of the affairs of the trust, and each one shall be answerable only for his own acts or neglects and not for those of any other person.

**4. AREA OF OPERATION:**

The trust is empowered to carry on the various activities in order to realize its objectives throughout India.

**5. ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT:**

5.1.1 The trustees are responsible for proper maintenance of books of account of the trust on an annual basis. The board of trustees shall maintain the accounts and the same shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant appointed by the board of trustees.

5.1.2 The first accounts of the trust shall be closed on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017 and thereafter at the end of every financial year beginning from 1<sup>st</sup> April and ending 31<sup>st</sup> March.

**6. TRUST RECORDS:**

All records, minute books, title deeds, securities account books, vouchers, papers and documents relating to the trust shall remain in the custody of the Managing Trustee or the President.

**7. IRREVOCABILITY:**

The trust is irrevocable and no part of the funds of the trust or income shall be taken directly or indirectly for the benefit of the Authors of the Trust, their families or the trustees or their families.

**8. OBJECTS OF THE TRUST:**

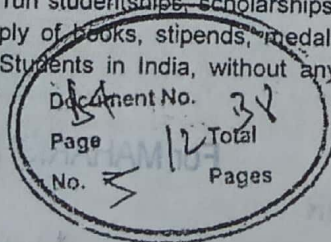
1 The objects of the Trust are:

- a.) 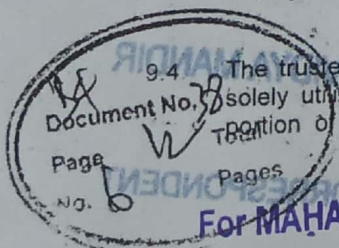

- c.) To Publish books of Literary, academic and Educative value which contribute to the objects
- d.) To develop a healthy as well as Critical attitude towards the Development of Mental, Physical and moral uplift of the Students
- e.) To aid Educational Institutions including Graduate, Post Graduate and Research Institutions, to promote and encourage education and diffusion of Knowledge in various Universities in India
- f.) To establish and run Special schools and Institutions for physically and mentally challenged people in the community
- g.) To provide counseling for the parents (parents who ill-treat the children) and give a happy family for the children
- h.) To undertake humanitarian social works during natural calamities such as floods, cyclone, earth-quakes etc
- i.) To run Meditation & Yoga training centres, Computer training centres and study centres
- j.) To receive and accept donations, gifts, subscriptions, grants for various National, International or Foreign organizations, Government organizations, Voluntary organizations, Trusts, Societies, Companies, Partnership Firms and Individuals towards the Corpus of the Trust or specifically for any particular objects of the Trust
- k.) To cooperate, collaborate, and carry on the objects of the Trust with other Trusts or Public bodies, or Institutions having similar objects or Governmental authorities
- l.) To charge fees and otherwise recoup themselves for the outlay and expenses incurred in running various activities carried by the Trust during promotion of its objectives
- m.) To develop required infrastructure, buildings and other assets necessary to carry out the objects of this Trust
- n.) Generally to do anything and everything to promote education and Research in any discipline

9. **GENERAL:**

- 9.1. It is hereby declared for the removal of doubts that the benefits of the services of the trust shall be open to all without any distinction on the basis of Caste, Creed, Community or religion.
- 9.2. It is also desired that any amendment to the deed of declaration affecting the applicability of Direct Tax Laws shall be carried out only with the prior approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax having jurisdiction. Such amendment or amendments shall not contravene the Provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- 9.3. The trustees shall invest such surplus funds of the trust that require investment only in the modes specified under the provisions of Section 13(1) (d) read with Section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 or such modes as may be prescribed by any subsequent alteration, amendment or addition to the said Act dealing with investment of trust moneys.

9.4. The trustees shall ensure at all times that the funds and income of the trust shall be solely utilized towards the achievement of the objects and aims of the trust and no portion of it shall be utilized for payment to the trustees by way of profit, interest

dividend and remuneration: provided however, the trustees are empowered to reimburse to themselves expenses validly incurred for the purposes of the trust.

- 9.5. In the event of dissolution or the winding up of the trust any assets remaining on the dissolution shall be transferred to another charitable trust, society or institution whose objects are similar to those of this trust and which is registered under section 12A of the Income Tax Act. In no event shall the assets so remaining be distributed amongst the trustees.
- 9.6. The trust shall not carry on any activity with the intention of earning profit to the trust and no activity of the trust shall be carried on outside India.
- 9.7. It shall be lawful for the trust to take over or amalgamate with another trust with similar aims and objectives.
- 9.8. The Trust is not holding any immovable Property as on this date.
- 9.9. Anything which is not mentioned specifically in the above Trust deed, the Trust Act will be applicable.
